What is Affiliation?

Affiliation is the process of adding students into your chapter, submitting these students to both State and National FCCLA, and submitting payment for these students (and advisers).

Successfully submitting your affiliation is how you become an Active chapter.

In Arkansas, an active chapter consists of at least 12 students and 1 adviser being affiliated. The system will automatically charge the affiliation rate for 12 students even if there are not 12 names listed. Each active adviser will be added to the affiliation as well. We highly encourage you to add in 12 names each year to fill these spots.

Affiliation is not complete until payment has been received and processed by National FCCLA.



Why Should You Affiliate?

When you affiliate you will gain and retain access to several resources that are located on the portal.

Competitive events guides, National Programs resources, National publications, lesson plans & answer guides, membership materials, and much more!

Chapters that are affiliated by the Arkansas deadline you will be eligible for District, State, and National Level trips, competitions, and recognition/rewards.

In Arkansas, having an affiliated chapter of the CTSO related to your Program of Study is a required portion of the Program Approval process.



Affiliation Deadlines

October 1st -

State Affiliation Deadline (access to competitive events, running for an office position, and membership awards/rewards)

November 1st -

National Affiliation Deadline (access to Portal Content, ability to attend National Competitions & Conferences, and the ability to earn National Recognition)



Types of Affiliation

Four Different Types:

Regular Afflation

100% Middle Level

Up to 25 Members

Unlimited Members



Regular Affiliation

Dues:

\$13.00 per person (including advisers) + \$10.00 chapter fee [\$9.00 for National Dues & \$4.00 for State Dues]

Remember: Affiliation is not complete until your membership invoice is paid through the National FCCLA Association.



100% Middle Level

One fee that will register all 7th - 9th grade students within the chapter.

You must either be a Middle School or Junior High chapter and <u>fill out this form</u> to qualify. This package requires manual changing of the affiliation type, please do not affiliate until you receive confirmation your affiliation type has been changed.

\$320

All packages include national/state dues for students and advisers and the one-time \$10 chapter fee.



Up to 25 Members

One fee to register up to 25 members in a chapter.

Each member after the 25th member will be charged normal affiliation fees. (\$13/per person)

\$500

Perks:

One (1) Adviser Academy Registration (\$90 Value)

One (1) National Program download of your choice (\$80 Value)

One (1) Lifetime Alumni & Associates membership for an individual of your choice. (\$150 Value)

Total Value = \$320

All packages include national/state dues for students and advisers and the one-time \$10 chapter fee.



Unlimited Members

One fee to register an unlimited amount of members into your chapter.

With this package, make sure to add all your members into your chapter as they join! Once you have paid the amount required for this package, members will become affiliated, and gain the benefits of an affiliated member as soon as they are added to your chapter.

\$1000

Perks:

One (1) Adviser Academy Registration (\$90 Value)

One (1) National Program download of your choice (\$80 Value)

One (1) Lifetime Alumni & Associates membership for an individual of your choice. (\$150 Value)

Total Value = \$320

All packages include national/state dues for students and advisers and the one-time \$10 chapter fee.
